

STRIDE: Mobility Across the Trajectory of Care

STRIDE is particularly well-suited to support Safe Patient Handling & Mobility in more independent patients in the **acute care setting**, freeing up provider time to deliver skilled therapy services to patients with elevated mobility needs. STRIDE functions in the acute care setting the way restorative nursing programs function in the long-term care setting and the way ABCDE Bundles work in critical care – preventing potentially costly and unwanted physical functional decline in patients. Maintaining physical function and independence in general medicine patients not only shortens average length of hospital stay, but also significantly reduces discharges to nursing homes, CLCs, or other long-term care setting. Both **shorter inpatient stays** and **discharges to home** are not only desirable for improving facility metrics, but also beneficial for our Veteran patients and their families who want to **minimize costs** and avoid institutional care.

Implementing STRIDE with Function QUERI

Function QUERI will recruit 8 VA Medical Centers every 6 months for a total of 32 sites. We are **now enrolling** the first cohort of 8 sites interested in launching a STRIDE mobility program. Staring this summer, Function QUERI (in partnership with VHA's Diffusion of Excellence) will provide sites with the following implementation resources:

Caregivers FIRST: Virtual Facilitation Lessons Learned after 1 Year of COVID Delivery

It's been just over one year since COVID-19 rapidly changed how Function QUERI sites delivered the largely in-person caregiver group training. On March 16th, 2020, the Function QUERI team gathered the eight "1.0" sites together to talk about how they could quickly transition to **virtual**

delivery. Leaning on the experience of TN Valley Healthcare System who had been the first site to implement a training remote, the group discussed and refined tips on virtual delivery. Over the course of a few quarterly Diffusion Network calls, sites continued to share lessons learned, ranging from technical tips to strategies on managing caregiver dynamics when not in a room together. From March through October of 2020, "1.0" Function QUERI sites were able to train 103 friend or family caregivers remotely during COVID-19! The Function QUERI team was able to conduct qualitative interviews with some of those caregivers (n=13) who did participate remotely either by phone, video connect, or web conference. Overall, caregivers appreciated




remote formats for a variety of reasons, including increased availability and ease due to not having to travel or find care for their Veteran loved one. Some caregivers noted a preference for inperson classes, which tied into themes of valuing caregiver connection. For example, these caregivers said that there was a "different feeling" being in the same room with others and that "there is an atmosphere of caring and listening" that is not present over the phone or computer; however, they thought the remote format worked well. The Function QUERI team has summarized best practices for virtual facilitation of the caregiver training program, as well as gathered resources for most-used virtual platforms on our SharePoint site.

Caregivers FIRST SharePoint:

Caregivers FIRST is Gearing UP!

In January 2021, the Function QUERI team administered a voluntary survey to all program managers in the Caregiver Support Program (CSP) to assess plans to implement Caregivers FIRST as well as readiness to implement along with anticipated barriers and facilitators. So far, about 67 VA Medical Centers indicated they will implement Caregivers FIRST this fiscal year as a "strong practice" program. All CSP programs have access to the Caregivers FIRST package and implementation support tools on our SharePoint site.



Group PT Recruitment
