

Caregivers FIRST Updates

Caregivers FIRST consists of 4 core modules, 6 optional topical videos/phone scripts, and 2 optional post-training "booster" sessions. Although the curriculum was originally delivered inperson, it was flexibly designed, allowing for adaptation and tailoring to increase fit to delivery staff and caregiver recipients. Many Caregivers FIRST sites continue to deliver the curriculum virtually post-COVID 19 because it allows for more participation of rural caregivers with long commutes to medical centers or other caregivers who have difficulty leaving the house.

At the December 2022 Caregivers FIRST Diffusion Network call, **Kasey Decosimo** and **Matthew Tucker** guided approximately 120 Caregiver Support Program field staff in an interactive gallery session to brainstorm ways to improve caregiver engagement in the core curriculum for ongoing virtual delivery. Field staff also provided feedback for overall curriculum updates and improvement.

Function QUERI will be going through the feedback and updating the curriculum this spring. - Boise VAMC (Boise, ID)


